

John 8:1-11
The Woman Caught in Adultery

1. What are one or two observations when reading through John 8:1-11?
2. The Feast of Booths (John 7) is about praying to God for rain (a blessing from God of good judgment), forgiveness, and thanking Him for what He has given. How might this relate to the woman caught in adultery?
3. What is Jesus' first reaction to the religious leaders? Why is it that? What would your first reaction be? John 8:6
4. What do you think Jesus is writing on the ground? John 8:6 & 8
5. Read John 7:37-39, then read Jeremiah 17:13. What are the parallels, between Jeremiah and John 7:37-39 & John 8:6 & 8?
6. Read Matthew 7:1-5. What might be the main point/points of this passage? What can you learn from it?
7. How might we apply this scripture to John 8:1-11?
8. What did this woman deserve according to the Law of Moses and the religious leaders? We have all sinned, what do we deserve? Romans 6:23
9. What did this woman that was caught in the act of adultery ask for? What did she receive? John 8:10-11
10. How powerful do you think it was for that woman to hear the words, I don't condemn you? Take some time to think about Jesus saying this to you for all of your sins you have committed. How powerful are those words for you?
11. The grace of God is amazing and absurd. We all deserve death! Read these passages about grace and reflect on them. Hebrews 13:9, Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 3:20-24, Titus 2:11
