Galatians 3:6-14

## QUESTIONS for REFLECTION

Six Old Testament quotations contrasting the difference between Law & grace and works (of the Law) & faith.

1. Quotation one, v. 6, is from Genesis 15:6. What did Abraham do? (And what was this in reference to?)

What was the result? And to what is this equivalent (c.f., 2:16)?

Who, then, are true sons of Abraham (v. 7)?

2. Quotation two, v. 8, is from Genesis 12:3. What did this Scripture foresee?

What is this blessing and who is blessed?

3. Quotation three, v. 10, is from Deuteronomy 27:26. Who is cursed? Contrast this to vv. 8-9 (Who was blessed?).

What results in this curse (c.f., James 2:10)?

4. Quotation four, v. 11, is from Habakkuk 2:4. How does the righteous man live? How did the righteous man become righteous (c.f., vv. 6-7)?

What does the Law (not) do?

5. Quotation five, v. 12, is from Leviticus 18:5. The emphasis in vv. 11 & 12 is how a person lives. Contrast the two ways.

Why does practicing the Law come up short (v. 12a)?

6. Quotation six, v. 13, is from Deuteronomy 21:23. What did Christ do for us?

How did Christ do it? What exactly does that mean?

What was the result (v. 14)?

What is the means?
