QUESTIONS for REFLECTION

1. Describe a covenant (consult a commentary or study Bible if needed) (v. 15).

Identify the elements of the promise (Genesis 12:1-3).

How did God affix His signature, as it were, to this promise/covenant (Genesis 15:9-18)?

What was the basis of this covenant (Hebrews 6:13-19)?

3. What was the nature of the covenant of the Law (vv. 19-20, 22)?

What was the Law unable to do? (Or, what did the promise do?)

4. What was the duration of the Law (as a covenant) (v. 19)?

How did God demonstrate that the Law had fulfilled its purpose (Luke 19:43-44)? (To what does this refer?)

6. How did the Law complement the promise (vv. 19, 22)?
