QUESTIONS for REFLECTION

1. Identify all the “one another” admonitions in the text. Which seems to be the primary, or over-arching, admonition?

2. Define a “trespass” (v. 1).

How does one become caught in a trespass?

3. How do we usually respond when a brother/sister is caught in a trespass?

What is the proper response to the brother/sister caught in a trespass?

4. Who is to respond to the trespasser?

How is the response to be made? What caution is to be exercised?

5. What does it really mean to be “spiritual”? (Who qualifies?)

6. How does bearing the burdens of others “fulfill the law of Christ” (v. 2)?

7. How do vv. 3 & 4 fit with the admonition of v. 2?

Identify the ways in which the text deals with the issue of pride. How are we to check our pride? What is my responsibility?

8. If we are to bear one another's burdens, what does it mean that "each one will bear his own load" (v. 5)?

9. What have I learned about my attitude and response to others (in their trespasses & burdens)?
