3. Discuss the differences between the scope of this mission (vv. 5-6) and the lifelong mission of the disciples/apostles (c.f., Matthew 28:19; Mark 16:15; Luke 24:47; Acts 1:8)?
4. How does their message of v. 7 compare with our message today?
5. What is established by the four-fold ministry described in v. 8? What does that mean today?
6. What is the intent behind vv. 8b-10?

Will this change (Luke 22:35-36)? (How will this change? What remains the same?)

7. Discuss their entrance/presence in a city/village/home (vv. 11-14). What is this to convey or meant to accomplish?

8. What would it mean to take back their peace (v. 13)? Does this not sound harsh?

What are the implications of shaking the dust off their feet (vv. 14-15)?
