## QUESTIONS for REFLECTION

1. For what does Jesus praise His Father (v. 25)? How does it strike you?
2. What are “these things”?

To what does the title “Lord of heaven and earth” refer or highlight? How does it relate to what is hidden and what is revealed?

3. Discuss the role of the Son in concealing or revealing *these things* (v. 27).

4. Identify Jesus’ simple invitation (v. 28).

For whom? What is likely in view here (c.f., Isaiah 1:4; Psalm 38:4)?

His promise? To what might this refer (c.f., Acts 3:19; 2:38)?

5. What dual demand does Jesus put before the respondent (v. 29)?

6. What is the nature of this yoke (vv. 29-30)? How does it differ from other yokes?

7. Is there a difference between the rest in v. 28 and the rest of v. 29? (If so, identify it.)

8. Can you describe a time when Jesus gave you (His supernatural) rest?
