

# APOCALYPSE NOW XXXVI

February 22, 2026

**READ:** Revelation 19:1-7

## QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

The sounds of *Hallelujah!* dominate this passage. Four hallelujahs are offered in six verses—the only passage in the New Testament where *hallelujah* appears. It means “Praise the LORD!”

1. Who lifts up the first two hallelujahs (vv. 1 & 3)?

Describe the essence of the first hallelujah (vv. 1-2).

Why focus upon God’s salvation, glory & power? (What difference does it make?)

Upon what are God’s “true and righteous” judgments based?

2. What is driving the second hallelujah (v. 3)? Compare the hallelujah of this verse with the following Scriptures—

- Exodus 15:1-2, 21
- Psalm 58:10-11
- Psalm 137:8-9
- Nahum 3:19
- 1 Samuel 2:1

How is the judgment upon the great harlot (aka Babylon the great) like a burnt offering?

3. Who lifts up the third hallelujah (v. 4)? (What sets them apart from the others?)

What is suggested by the third hallelujah?

4. Who introduces the fourth hallelujah (v. 5)?

Who will lift up this praise?

Who are they? How are they characterized?
