READ: Revelation 19:11-16

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

This study focuses on four righteous actions of the Rider on the white horse in this passage.

1. Identify the first (dual) action of the Rider in v. 11.

What is the basis of His judgment & war-making?

What difference does this make in His judgment & war-making (and all His actions)?

2. Three more actions follow in v. 15. Each is introduced with the pronoun *He*. Identify the second action of the Rider.

By what means will the Rider strike them down? Unpack this.

- Isaiah 11:1-4
- 2 Thessalonians 2:8
- Revelation 2:15-16
- Ephesians 6:17

Who, among the nations, are to be struck down?

- Revelation 11:18
- Revelation 13:7
- Revelation 14:8; 18:3
- Revelation 18:23; 20:8

Who, among the nations, are *not* to be struck down? (Why?)

- Revelation 5:9
- Revelation 7:9
- Revelation 21:24, 26

3. Identify the third action of the Rider in v. 15.

By what means will He “rule” the nations? What is suggested by this?

Amazingly, what role will those who follow the Rider share?

- Revelation 2:25-27
- 1 Corinthians 6:2-3

4. Identify the fourth action of the Rider in v. 15 (cf. Revelation 14:17-20).

What are the two prominent features of this wrath?

Who are the targets of this wrath? Why?
