What was the fate of the tree of life (Genesis 3:22-24)? Why?

4. How is (redeemed) man reunited with the tree of life (v. 3a)?

Where did the curse(s) come from (Genesis 3:17-19)?

How were the curses undone (Galatians 3:13)?

5. Describe the situation for the bond-servants of God (vv. 3b-5). What does this say to you?

6. Why has “the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel so show to His bond-servants the things which must take place” (v. 6)? Why has He told you all this?

7. Why is the promise of v. 7 so important?

8. What is the blessing of v. 7? What does this emphasize?
