QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. Identify the first Offerer of an invitation.

To whom is He extending His invitation (cf. vv. 7, 12)?

Why would the Spirit extend such an invitation to Jesus (cf. John 16:14)?

2. Identify the second offerer of an invitation. To whom does this metaphor apply (Revelation 19:7-8; Ephesians 5:25-27)?

Why would “the bride” (the Church) extend such an invitation to Jesus (the Bridegroom) in union with the Spirit?

What is to be our attitude toward the coming of our Bridegroom? What would prompt such an invitation on our part?

Why do we not consistently exhibit such attitudes? What do we allow to interfere with these attitudes? (What must change?)

3. Identify the third offerer of an invitation. To whom does this apply (cf. Revelation 1:3; 2:7, 11, 17, 29: 3:6, 13, 22)?

To whom is *this* invitation to be extended (cf. v. 17b)?

Reflect on this invitation in action in John 1:35-49. (What does this look like?)

What does this mean for you? (The hearer is to become the _____.)

4. To whom does the last invitation apply?

What alone can quench this thirst (John 7:37)?

What can the thirsty expect (John 6:35, 37; 7:38)?

Why is living water offered “without cost” (1 Peter 1:18-19)?
