READ: Revelation 22:18-21

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. A final warning is issued in vv. 18-19. This warning does not apply simply to the Book of Revelation. How so?

- Deuteronomy 4:2
- Deuteronomy 12:32
- Proverbs 30:5-6
- Jeremiah 26:2

Why is maintaining “the pure milk of the word” (1 Peter 2:2) so important?

2. A final promise is made in v. 20a. Why is this promise from Jesus so significant (Titus 2:13)?

How does this promise affect your priorities?

How does this promise help you be prepared for Jesus’ coming?

3. A final prayer is offered in v. 20b. Do you really mean this prayer? How does this prayer affect your attitude toward Jesus’ coming?

Describe the way in which this prayer can help align your life with the Lord's will.

How does this prayer reflect how secure you are, or are not, in your faith in Jesus?

4. A final blessing is given in v. 21. Why is it fitting that the Bible ends on this note?

How does this grace sustain you as you wait for the return of God's Son?

What changes if you read the Book of Revelation through the lens of grace?

Am I ready *today* for Christ's return? What do I need to do to be ready? . . .
